Featured at this meeting will be spectacular Great Smoky Mountains National Park.

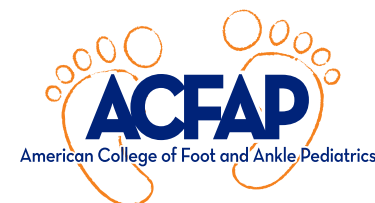
#### At the Conclusion of this meeting, the attendee shall be able to:
