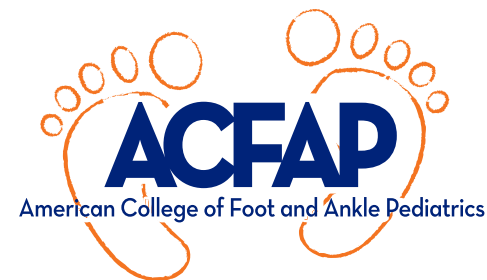

Featured at this meeting will be the spectacular Joshua Tree National Park.

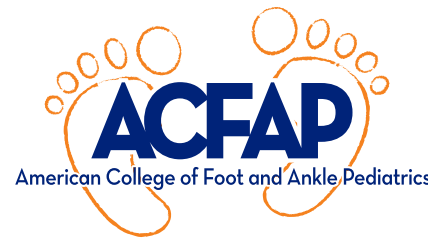
**At the Conclusion of this meeting, the attendee shall be able to:**
